Functional Anatomy of the Respiratory System. The nasal cavity, the chamber within the nose, is divided medially by a nasal septum and separated from the oral cavity by the palate (Figure 13.1). The nasal cavity is lined with a mucosa, which warms, filters, and moistens incoming air.
