For example, failure to carry out instructions as given by the manager or when an employee has the tendency of submitting their reports late, you can warn them verbally.

Editors have a duty to act if they suspect misconduct by an author. 1 However, since they are not equipped to investigate misconduct allegations or impose punishment they must rely on the author's institution. 2 The Committee on Publication Ethics' (COPE) code of conduct states that "Editors should make all reasonable efforts to ensure that a proper investigation is conducted."

Cases of research misconduct (RM) continue unabated around the world. In the US, ORI reports new allegations rising from 86 in 1993 to 154 in 2012 (Office of Research Integrity [ORI], 2012). Others recently reported include lack of acknowledgement in the peer reviewed literature of findings by the FDA of fabricated and/or falsified data (Seife, 2015).
