The risk of breast cancer is much lower in men than in women. The lifetime risk of getting breast cancer is about 1 in 833 for men in the U.S. compared to 1 in 8 for women in the U.S. . From 2000-2018 (most recent data available), the incidence of male breast cancer in the U.S. remained stable .
