Open the hood and pull the transmission dipstick out of the transmission filler neck. The transmission dipstick is a red loop-handled dipstick that sits in the back of the engine bay near the firewall. Wipe off the end of the dipstick then put it all the way back into the transmission filler neck. Pull it back out again and check the fluid level.

Manual: Checking the transmission fluid in a manual transmission can be difficult. A few thoughtful manufacturers have included a dipstick, but that's the exception rather than the rule. If you own a car with a manual transmission, we suggest that you ask your mechanic to check the fluid level when your car is up on the lift during an oil change.

Manual transmissions are a little different than their auto counterparts in the fluid checking department. On manuals, they have a plug on the side of the transmission that acts as the fill hole, and the check level hole. The way to check the level is to remove the plug, and insert the bent end of an Allen key into the hole.
