

## Will 5w30 Oil Hurt My Engine In Ford Escape

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**Will 5w30 Oil Hurt My**  
5W-30 and 5W-20 motor oil both feature the same winter rating. This means that both grades exhibit the same viscosity under cold conditions. However, 5W-30 features a slightly higher viscosity at 100 degrees Celsius than does 5W-20. This means that once the engine reaches normal operating temperature, 5W-30 oil will be thicker than 5W-20.

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Using 10W-30 instead of 5W-30, however, could make cold starts more difficult. It's helpful to think of the "W" as standing for "winter." The lower the oil's "W" viscosity, the more readily it will flow when cold. In this case, 5W-30 will flow more easily at startup than 10W-30.

So for example, a straight 20W oil or 30W oil with no viscosity improvers in it would have more lubricating oil than a 5W-20 or 5W-30 oil. So in short, given your climate, I see no harm, and perhaps a small benefit in doing what your mechanic did.

**Will it hurt my town car if i use 5w30 instead of 5w20**  
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That's why we use a multigrade oil like 5w30. Based on what I've told you about viscosity so far, I bet you can start to guess the difference between 5w20 and 5w30. If you guessed that 5w30 is thicker than 5w20 at normal operating temperature, you'd be right.

**5w20 vs 5w30 - Which Grade Motor Oil Should I Use ...**  
So running 5W-30 will not hurt the engine at all but may lower your fuel economy slightly. For an older truck with some engine wear, it may even help lubricate better than the slightly thinner 5W-20 oil. Startup is actually the worst time for engine wear when there's just a thin film of unpressurized oil between metal parts like bearings.

**5w30 accedently instead of 5w20? | Ford**  
Went to the Audi dealer for the first service. at 5K miles today. The dealer put in 5w-30 oil, and sold me an extra quart of 5w-30 oil-- didn't notice until I had driven away. The oil meets VW 507.00 The Owner's Manual gives 5w-40 as the preferred oil and 5w-30 or 0w-40 as acceptable...

5W-30 motor oil is another very good and highly efficient motor oil Check Price 5W-30 oils are better in the cold atmosphere for good begin. 5W-30 as multi-grade oil is used vastly under extreme weather either it is the warm or cold state. 5w-30 oils are thin which makes flow at low temperatures and shows their thickness for performing good enough at high temperatures.

**What if I Use 0w-20 instead of 5w30? Mr Tonneau**  
nothing. all my cars call for 5w-30 and I put 10w-30 in them all, just if you live in a colder climate. you probably would be better off to put 5w-20 in it so it can start easier. but other then that just stay away from really thick stuff like 40 or 50. you can start to mess things up.

**if ur car calls for 5w20 oil and u put 5w30 will it harm ...**  
That's not correct. At low temperatures, 3W-20 will behave the same as 5W30. But more importantly, at normal operating temperatures, one will flow like 30 weight, the other will flow like 20 weight. That can be important or even critical to engine operation. It can impact oil pressure and oil flow rates.
